Subject: Approval - rebranded FRALO septic tanks to Roth Multi Tank models

Dear Mr. Brown:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated March 26, 2008 concerning the acquisition of FRALO assets and the subsequent rebranding of the FRALO Septech line of septic tanks to accommodate the Roth Multi Tank brand.

Pursuant to your request, the line of Roth septic and pump tanks heretofore branded FRALO Septech models -"ST" and now rebranded as Roth Multi Tank models -"RMT" maintains product approval for sale in the state of Georgia. Departmental records have been changed and the official web site listing of approved polyethylene septic tanks has been updated. Continued approval of the tanks under rebranding is based upon the assertion of Roth Global Plastics, Inc. that the manufacturing process of the Roth "RMT" model tanks is identical to the FRALO "ST" models including materials, third party structural testing, manufacturing process, weight, material distribution, quality control/assurance with the only difference being the color of the tanks. The color change is from blue to black. The new designations are as follows:

Roth Multi Tank Models

Septic Tanks – RMT 1000E; RMT 1060; RMT 1250; RMT 1500

Pump Tanks – RMT 300; RMT 500; RMT 750; RMT 900; RMT 1000E; RMT 1060; RMT 1250; RMT 1500

The Department reserves the right to conduct on-site field evaluations of your manufacturing plant as well as any field installations involving your tanks as deemed necessary. Department of Human Resources Division of Public Health staff or Environmental Health personnel employed by a County Board of Health may conduct inspections. Such evaluations may include evaluating your products to ensure that they meet specifications, detailed in your plans, in accordance with *the Manual*.
